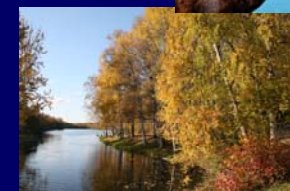

The Program has been successful in producing quality teachers, a high percentage of whom are men and minorities. This program also provides tuition assistance for teacher certification and a bonus for teaching in a high needs school.

Our Goals

Job Placement Assistance

Financial Assistance

Provide financial assistance in terms of stipends and bonuses, for qualified personnel. Up to \$10,000 available.
