

SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Adelson Scholarship**

Amount: Three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each will be awarded. The scholarships may be renewable for up to three additional years for a total of \$8,000 for each scholarship.

Eligibility: CCSD seniors who are interested in pursuing a career in the field of health services at an accredited college or university may apply for this scholarship. A minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA is required and students must demonstrate financial need.

- **A Better Slice for Education-PaPa John's Pizza Scholarship**

Amount: Five scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each will be offered. Two will be awarded to Hispanic applicants.

Eligibility: Need-based \$2,000 undergraduate studies grants to children of: active-duty members, Title 10 Air Guard Reserve(AGR)/Reserve, Title 32 AGR performing full-time active duty, retired, retired reserve and deceased Air Force members, spouses (stateside) of active-duty members and Title 10 AGR/Reservists, and surviving spouses of deceased personnel. *Senior NCOs and officers are highly encouraged to apply. This program is tailored for Air Force families with college students.*
